Wound Management: Beyond the Basics

Week 1: Introduction, Wound Assessment and Documentation

Important aspects of the function and physiology of the integumentary system in the healing process; Systemic and local factors that affect wound healing; Tools for concise wound documentation including assessment, problem identification, and goals.

Week 2: Nutrition and Wound Management

Major nutrition issues associated with wounds including inflammatory stress, involuntary weight loss and reduced dietary intake; Factors that contribute to involuntary weight loss (IWL), anorexia and slow healing wounds; Nutrition assessment; NPUAP nutrition recommendations including prevention and treatment; Nutritional interventions to standardize care.

Week 3: Lower Extremity Ulcer Assessment and Management

Pathophysiology and treatments of Arterial, Venous Leg, and Diabetic/Neuropathic Ulcers including vascular assessment, risk factors and patient history, signs and symptoms/assessment, and plan of care.

Week 4: Pressure Ulcer Assessment and Management

Identifying and staging pressure ulcers; Tools to develop a plan of care for contributory factors of pressure ulcers; Treatment plans to achieve an optimum wound bed; Overview of adjunctive modalities.

Week 5: The Psychosocial Aspect of Wound Healing

How psychological and emotional health can affect wound healing; Assessing the psychosocial domain of wound patients; Challenges that persons living with chronic wounds and their caregivers face.

Week 6: Advanced Wound Treatments and Dressings

Evidence based criteria and considerations will be presented for wound treatments (debridement, negative pressure wound therapy, hyperbaric oxygen therapy, skin substitutes) and wound dressings (traditional and newer market) along with case studies.
